The MS Developer will design, develop, and maintain custom solutions within the Microsoft 365 ecosystem to enable preventive interventions across services and enable productivity and efficiency opportunities.

2. Key accountabilities:

The MS Developer will:

- Develop and implement solutions using the full range of Microsoft development suite tools.
- Work with a wide range of colleagues and stakeholders to deliver for services across the organisation.
- Arrange for and maintain Microsoft platform tools after deployment, ensuring they remain functional and effective.
- Develop tools for use by as wide a range of staff as possible, bringing in low and no code concepts, and ensuring solutions are as accessible as possible.
- Be involved in the development of the Council's solutions architecture, taking account of latest developments in the sector.
- Ensure effective data management and governance within SharePoint by designing and maintaining structured document libraries, implementing metadata and content types, configuring permissions for secure access, and integrating SharePoint as a reliable data source for automation and application solutions.
- Create and maintain clear technical documentation for developed solutions, including architecture diagrams, users guides, and troubleshooting steps
- Use their knowledge and experience of coding to identify creative solutions to longstanding problems.
- Share knowledge with colleagues through workshops, peer code reviews or other knowledge sharing approaches to build capability and best practice standards across the team and the wider organisation
- Implement robust testing practices, including unit testing and integration testing, to ensure reliability and performance of solutions

- Monitor solutions for performance and reliability, proactively identifying and resolving issues.
- Design solutions that integrate with existing legacy systems and external APIs, ensuring interoperability across the council's technology stack.
- Be aware of developments in the Microsoft ecosystem and beyond and be ready to apply these as solutions across the Council where they add value.
- Explore opportunities for AI, machine learning and advanced analytics to enhance council services.
- Work in an agile development and in a multi-disciplinary team environment and embed this approach into council working practices.
- Contribute to the development and maintenance of automated deployment and version control best practices ensuring smooth transitions of solutions from development to production.
- Assist with the development of a development architecture, providing scalability and consistency across the Council's tech estate.
- Ensure that all solutions and architecture adhere to security best practices, including role-based access controls, data encryption, and compliance with UK GDPR and council policies.
- Work as part of a multi-disciplinary team and will need to influence and direct other staff as appropriate
