

Job Description: Lunchtime Play Leader / Mealtime Supervisor

We are seeking a dedicated and enthusiastic **Lunchtime Play Leader / Mealtime Supervisor** to join our team. The successful candidate will work in partnership with parents, teachers, and school staff to create a safe, supportive, and nurturing environment for our pupils during the lunchtime period.

Main Duties - Lunchtime Responsibilities

- Supervise and engage with children in a positive manner during lunchtime, including leading structured play, sports, and traditional playground games.
- Foster a lunchtime environment that is enjoyable, inclusive, and continuously improving.
- Prepare the dining hall before lunch and ensure all areas are tidied afterwards (paid time allocated daily).
- Work collaboratively with colleagues and school staff, demonstrating a flexible and enthusiastic approach.
- Monitor children in the playground with vigilance, ensuring their safety and wellbeing.
- Support children in becoming independent eaters, including teaching the correct use of cutlery.
- Observe and monitor pupils' food intake, reporting concerns where appropriate.

Main Duties - Classroom Responsibilities (if applicable)

- Support individuals or groups of children with their learning under the direction of teaching staff.
- Assist teachers in assessing individual pupil needs.
- Observe, record, and provide feedback on pupil performance as required.

Additional Responsibilities

- Promote the general welfare and safety of all pupils, assisting First Aiders where necessary, including caring for unwell children and helping with changing clothes when appropriate.
- Maintain accurate behaviour and first aid records.
- Undertake additional tasks to support the day-to-day running of the school, as directed by the Head of School or designated staff member.
- Promote the inclusion of all pupils, including those with physical, learning, or behavioural needs.



- Support with behaviour management in line with the school's behaviour policy.
- Demonstrate a strong commitment to safeguarding and follow the school's safeguarding procedures at all times.

Wider School Support

- Maintain confidentiality regarding pupils and families at all times.
- Attend regular training and staff meetings as required.
- Communicate professionally and appropriately with staff, pupils, parents, governors, and the wider school community.
