Job Title: Mathematics Teacher

Reports to: Head of Mathematics

Job Purpose: The Mathematics Teacher develops students' academic curiosity and enables all students in all years to become confident learners and to reach their full potential in mathematics.

The School is seeking a Teacher of Mathematics to join a very successful team.

Responsibilities

1. Teach Mathematics within the National Curriculum Guidelines.
2. Plan and prepare lessons.
3. Ensure all students make progress.
4. Work in collaboration with colleagues to ensure that learning is kept within curriculum targets.
5. Assess and mark students' work according to departmental and school policies.
6. Record and report on the development, progress and attainment of pupils including attending meetings with parents to discuss attainment and progress.
7. Keep a disciplined class whilst promoting the general well-being of children.
8. Participate in the provision of co-curricular activities and clubs.
9. Share good practice in teaching and learning within the department.
10. Carry out the necessary administration tasks as required.
11. Carry out break duties as timetabled or when necessary.
12. Attend school meetings and In Service Training as and when required.
13. Maintain an appropriate awareness of and work effectively within the policies and procedures of the school.
14. Behave professionally at all times and maintain confidentiality of information.
15. Promote and safeguard the welfare of the pupils that fall under your responsibility or that you come into contact with.
16. Such other duties that the Headteacher may reasonably and from time to time require.
